



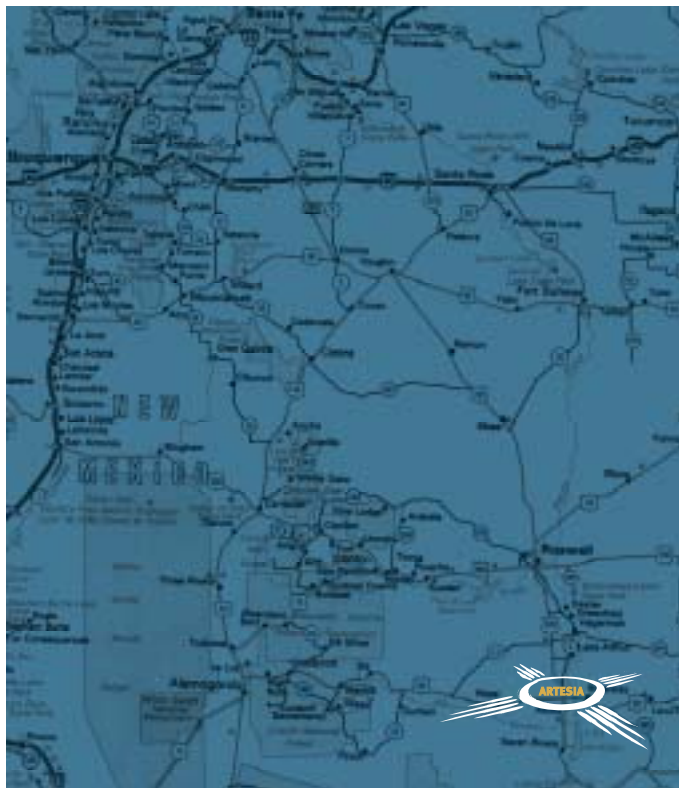
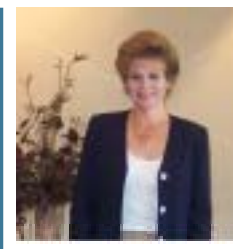

TRUCK DRIVING TRAINING
