- The number and types of types of jobs to be created, both temporary construction jobs and permanent jobs
- Pay scales for all jobs created
- Determination of which jobs are expected to be filled locally and which will be filled by transfers from other facilities or recruited from outside the Artesia are
- Total payroll expected at start-up and after one year
- Anticipates impact of project on local tax base
- Anticipated impact on local schools system and hospital and medical facilities
